OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CADDO LEVEE DISTRICT
AT REGULAR MEETING HELD ON MAY 14th, 2026

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Caddo Levee District held at 10:00 a.m., May 14th, 2026, at 1320 Grimmert Drive, Shreveport, Louisiana, the following members were present: Patrick W. Harrison, Kandi Moore, Jackie Baker, and Willie Walker. Carolyn C. Prator and James T. Sims were unable to attend.

The following people were also present: Ronald F. Lattier, Law Offices of Ronald F. Lattier; Marshall Jones, J. Marshall Jones Jr., (APLC) a Professional Law Corporation; Joshua Monroe, LA Department of Transportation and Development; John Barr, Regional Director, Senator John Kennedy's Office; Patrick Furlong, P.E., Executive Director; Sam Brimer, Maintenance Director; and Penny Adams, HR Analyst were also present.

The meeting was opened with prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

President Harrison asked for any comments from the public regarding agenda items or other issues.

President Harrison stated that the minutes from the April 9th, 2026, meeting had been emailed for review and asked for a motion to approve. Mrs. Moore made a motion, with a second by Mr. Baker, to approve the minutes of the April 9th, 2026, meeting. The motion unanimously passed.

Vice President Moore discussed the April monthly financial reports and reported on a static month with a healthy balance of all accounts.

The Board reviewed payments and invoices for the month of April 2026 and subsequent bills for the month of March 2026. Mrs. Moore made a motion, with a second from Mr. Walker, to ratify payment of the invoices for the month of April 2026 and subsequent bills for the month of March 2026. The motion unanimously passed.

The Board opened the meeting to a public hearing to discuss the budget of Caddo Levee District for the 2026-2027 fiscal year with a motion by Mr. Walker and a second by Mrs. Moore. The Board discussed the proposed budget and reviewed in detail the projected revenues and expenditures for the 2026-2027 fiscal year. There were no public comments. The public hearing was closed with a motion by Mr. Walker and a second by Mr. Baker.

The Board unanimously passed the following resolution (2 of 2026) to approve the operating budget for the Caddo Levee District 2026-2027 fiscal year with a motion by Mrs. Moore and a second by Mr. Walker:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Caddo Levee District in legal session convened, that:

Section 1: The attached estimate of revenues for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027, be and the same is hereby adopted to serve as an operating budget of revenues for the District, during same period.

Section 2: The attached estimates of expenditures for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027, be and the same is hereby adopted to serve as a budget of expenditures for the District during the said period.

Section 3: The adoption of the operating budget of expenditures be and the same is hereby declared to operate as an appropriation of the amount therein set forth within the terms of the budget classification.

Section 4: Amounts are available for expenditures only to the extent included within the 2026-2027 fiscal year budget.

The resolution having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:

being a top priority, river levels, profit and loss charts from a twelve-month and 10-year average view, and other matters. He specifically discussed plans for upcoming USACE levee inspections, MPC rezoning for a tractor shed, the MS4 permit, older pump station, ditch paving funds for lobbying, CURRENT meeting update, SWEPCO permitting issues, and other upcoming permit requests.

Maintenance Director, Mr. Brimer, gave his report on current forestry work and field crew activities, grading preparations for the levee gravel project, and use of all new equipment for cutting and bushhogging.

There was no Engineer's Report.

There was no Board Legal Counsel Report.

Marshall Jones reported on the District's oil and gas commodity pricing, as well as other mineral company acquisitions and requests.

There were no Committee Reports.

With no further business or comments from Commissioners to be brought before the Board, Mr. Walker made a motion to adjourn, with a second by Mr. Baker. The motion unanimously passed, and the meeting was adjourned.
